MEMBERSHIP YEAR -

Membership in FCA is prerequisite for membership in any of the FCA divisions and membership in at least one division is required. FCA operates on an anniversary renewal date basis. Members can join at any time during the year and be in good standing for 12 full months. Dues are renewed again 12 months from the month of initial affiliation. FCA dues are non refundable.

RENEWAL NOTICES -

Two months prior to the membership renewal date, an email reminder will be sent. If after 60 days the membership dues have not been received, that membership is placed in an inactive status and is removed from the active membership contact list. When the renewal dues are received, the membership will be reactivated.

MEMBERSHIP REACTIVATION -

Membership can be reactivated at anytime by logging onto the FCA web site (www.flacounseling.org), or by contacting the FCA Office (FCAoffice@aol.com) for a membership application.
